Well dear constituents did we do well during Make Your Mark as a constituency. We got over 50% of the overall ballots cast within the county of Hampshire, all thanks to the amazing work that the teachers in charge put in, arranging ballots being completed, visits to the school and then collection of the ballots afterwards. Believe me: counting those ballots was a nightmare. Next year, I think we will develop an online version of the ballot so it is easier on admin and doesn't take HOURS of counting afterwards – even better for the environment also!


